

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is recognized by **CHJA, CHSA, NEHC, MHC, MHJ** or **M&S** will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA, CHSA, NEHC, MHC, MHJ and M&S Rules. To show in CHJA or NEHC Medal classes, riders **MUST** be members. In order to compete for CHJA, CHSA or NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA, CHSA or NEHC and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA, CHSA or NEHC. A copy of the CHJA, CHSA and NEHC Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net, www.chsaonline.com & www.nehc.info.

1. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management. Windcrest Farm will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Windcrest Farm and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show.
2. If any questions or disputes arise, same will be referred to the steward & show committee, whose decision shall be final.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any classes if in its opinion the entries so warrant, while maintaining minimum CHJA, CHSA, NEHC or M&S requirements to fill a class.
4. Please make it easier for our Show Secretary and Pre Enter at least 24 hours before the start of the show. There will be a \$25 Post Entry Fee.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for having accurate and current memberships for all organizations which require the same. Any fines levied against the horse show for incorrect exhibitor memberships shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
6. \$50 Fee for any returned checks, or unpaid entries that must be billed.
7. Any dogs on the property **MUST** be leashed and under control. \$50 fine for loose or unruly dogs.
8. Windcrest Farm will follow the most current State of CT, Department of Agriculture COVID-19 GUIDANCE FOR EQUESTRIAN COMPETITIONS in an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in addition to guidance provided by the Center for Disease Control and Preventions (CDC, USDA and other federal agencies. Exhibitor Guidelines are provided in the prize list and are available in the Secretary's booth.

2020 Windcrest Farm COVID-19 Guidelines

The COVID-19 pandemic has affected us all in unprecedented ways. We are all excited to be able to horse show again and to welcome you back to Windcrest Farm. It has been a long time. So, let's get back in the saddle again with a few simple guidelines!

1. It would really help us a lot if you would pre-enter. With the State Guidelines that must be followed, the Show Secretary has a lot of extra duties. Pre entering will give her ample time to process your entries and know what the class counts are.
2. When you arrive at Windcrest Farm be prepared! NEHC and the CHSA require waivers which are on the Windcrest web site. Print them in advance and have them signed by everyone accompanying you before you arrive. We cannot let you on the grounds without them.
3. Next, we will do a mandatory temperature check. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 degrees will not be permitted to enter.
4. Masks or face coverings must always be worn when not mounted. Anyone wishing to show with a mask or face cover is welcome to do so without penalty. Attendees must provide their own masks.
5. We can only open the show grounds to riders, trainers, grooms, and show staff. Minor riders may have one legal guardian to accompany them. For now, there can be no spectators. We will miss the friends and family that have to stay at home, but hopefully it won't be for too long.
6. Exhibitors are not permitted to hang at the in gate and watch or linger throughout the day. At the completion of your classes, please checkout with the secretary and leave. Most division results will be available by the time you put your horse away. Ribbons will be handed to you by the secretary.
7. The trainers are responsible for their clients and staff to make sure all those affiliated with them are adhering to the rules.
8. No more than 2 people at a time will be allowed near in the Show Secretary booth or at the ingate.
9. Please maintain 6-foot social distancing at all times while on the property—this includes the parking areas, schooling area, ingate and show secretary booth.
10. Bring a picnic! We will not have a food truck but we will have bottled water available for purchase.
11. In the event of a storm, we ask that you shelter in your cars and NOT in the barn or show secretary booth. 12. There will be numerous hand sanitizing stations located throughout the farm. Please utilize them frequently.
